• Grande Cuvée Spumante, Gold, Iris Vigneti (Italie)

Very aromatic and charming nose, reminiscent of acacia flowers, applesauce, pineapple, as well as lightly toasted brioche. The palate is elegant, offering balanced mellowness and fresh acidity. The finish, quite long, presents notes of honey.

• Pinar Del Villena (Spain)

Bright and lively with a fresh citrus attack and gooseberry notes. Easy to drink and well-balanced.

• La Villa Real (Spain)

This pale white wine offers an intense bouquet dominated by the fruity and floral scents typical of Sauvignon blanc. The palate, round and fat, is carried by citrus notes and hints of wood. The fresh finish leaves a pleasant sweetness in the mouth.

• Autocarro No 38 (Portugal)

Intense nose with citric notes and the scent of stone evoking a mineral touch. Good acidity and not aggressive on the palate. A palate with a solid minerality and once again, very pleasant citric notes.

• Mâcon-Villages, Domaine Romanin (Bourgogne, France)

This wine is bright, crystalline, limpid and has good concentration. This wine gradually exhales subtle aromas of white flowers, citrus and dried fruits (hazelnut). The palate plays on the fruit (grapefruit) and minerality (gun flint) ratio, affirming a nice balance.

• Pinar Del Villena (Spain) The color is nice dark and the scent mild and finely seasoned. In the taste you sense ripe black berries, plums and a harmoniously spicy aftertaste.

• La Dernière Goutte (France) This Grenache-Syrah duo (80-20) has an intense robe edged with violet and offers a powerful bouquet of forest fruits, spices and cocoa. The aromas blossom in a generous and suave mouth, with melted and silky tannins.

- Long Barn , Pinot Noir (California)

 This Pinot promises plenty of raspberry and bright cherry on the nose mixed with slightly earthy undertones and a hint of vanilla spice. The palate shows a berry blend of raspberry, strawberry, and cherry with delicate textures and a medium bodied style.
- Casa Di Monti, Chianti DOCG (Italy)

 Rich bouquet of cherries and berries. A touch of violet and refreshing acidity
 typical of Sangiovese combined with the sweetness of Canaiolo, Trebbiano and
